- (a) What are the specific lessons learnt by Nils Holgersson during his adventures? Elaborate on any one such lesson with the help of illustrative episodes from the novel.
- (b) Show how Kadare subverts the act of interpretation in *The File on H* through the comic effects of misreadings and misunderstandings.

- (c) How does Borges the narrator give a sense of the infinite that he sees within the Aleph? Reflect on the challenge of rendering the simultaneous in language that is successive and comment on the list of sights that he enumerates.
- (d) Write critically on the patriarchal order represented in *Shame* as expressed through questions of shame and honour, using relevant instances from the novel.
- (e) Comment on how the figure of Memed as a legendary folk hero is created through narrative accounts and descriptions embedded into the novel, Memed, My Hawk.
- (f) What constitutes the 'modern' in Botchan? Discuss the journey of the narrator in Botchan-from childhood to adulthood, and from Tokyo to the countryside to take up the job of a teacher in a school-as representative of the arrival of the modern era in Japan.
